

The Brown ADD Scales for Assessment of Executive Function Impairments in ADHD

This presentation will describe a new model of ADHD as developmental impairment of executive functions, the management system of the brain. Derived from clinical research with this model, the Brown ADD Scales assess a wide range of executive function impairments in children (3-12 yrs., adolescents (12-18 yrs.) and adults. Dr. Brown will explain use of these normed scales in conjunction with the Brown ADD Diagnostic Forms for clinical interviews, WISC/WAIS-IQ subtest score analysis, verbal memory measures and a comorbidity screener.
